With this production of Richard III, the director and I wanted to evoke the celebratory state of a nation post-war with a shiny new leader and show how quickly that nation can be shifted into a new regime. The start of the play is evocative of post WWI America, and as Richard claims the throne we shift dramatically into a militarized guerilla visualization. This company utilizes many original practices such as natural lighting, limited scenery, and double and cross-gender casting.
